

SYRAH WINE LIST

BADGER MOUNTAIN - Syrah Columbia Valley 2007 (Organic) (No sulfites added)

A bit lighter than most Syrah, with a green edge to the pretty black fruit flavors. Finishes with some generosity. **\$11.82**

BANROCK STATION - Shiraz South Eastern Australia 2006

On the lighter side, but generous, with pretty plum and cherry fruit, finishing with sweet spices in the mix. **\$6.20**

BONNY DOON - Syrah Central Coast Le Pousseur 2004

A decent quaff. A bit generic, but shows just enough blueberry, plum and spice notes to make it interesting. **\$14.75**

CLINE – 2006 Cool Climate Syrah

Long associated with the northern Rhône Valley of France, Syrah has been used for centuries to produce some of the world's finest wines. This Cool Climate Syrah is no exception. This wine offers rich blueberry and black pepper characters finishing with a hint of cedar. **\$13.35**

EMERSON – 2006 Syrah – LAST YEAR!!!

Emerson Vineyards Syrah is a near-opaque, saturated ruby color. Smoky, brambly fruit aromas give way to a robust palate of juicy blueberry, blackberry, vanilla, pepper, and pie spice. Rich, weighty texture and fine-grained tannins round out the mid-palate and finish. Pair with ribs, Indian fare, or bittersweet chocolate. **\$16.50**

FRENCHMAN HILLS - 2005 Tier 2 Syrah

A Premium Syrah. Consisting of aromas and flavors of cassis, black fruits, cedar, and spice. Raspberries, leather, tobacco add to the complexity of this wine. Balances fruit and oak tannins and finishes rich and bursting. **\$32.70**

MICHAEL DAVID - Syrah Lodi 6th Sense 2004

Ripe, spicy and rather pruny, with simple, dried-out flavors. **\$14.95**

RED KNOT - Shiraz McLaren Vale 2006

Smooth and velvety, with dried cherry and ripe plum flavors that linger against mild tannins. **\$9.90**

SAINT ALICIA

COLOUR Intense red and purple tones

AROMA With aromas of violets, black pepper and oak

PALATE Elegant and persistent tannins, with a long finish - **\$10.00**

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SPANGLER 2006 Syrah

A very ripe Syrah with a nice floral, red fruit nose. Soft and fruity with flavors of black cherry and blackberry, gliding to a round, smoky, toasty finish. **\$13.60**

TERRA BLANCA - Syrah Red Mountain 2000

Crisp, with firm tannins and ripe cherry, berry and pepper flavors coming through and persisting on the finish. **\$13.30**

VIRGIN VINES - Shiraz California 2006

Smooth, with ripe, juicy plum and wild berry fruit that drinks easy. **\$8.40**

VITIS RIDGE - Wahluke Slope • Syrah 2005

Dark purple in color with flavors of dried fruit, raspberry and blackberry, this Syrah was aged in a combination of American and French Oak barrels. The combination of low yields, meticulous vineyard management and picking when the flavors are right create a complex wine with a pleasant finish. **\$16.00**

PETITE SIRAH'S

BOGLE - Petite Sirah California 2006

Wild berry flavors are plump and ripe, with good concentration, a full body and spice and floral notes. Easy-drinking, with a tea like dryness on the finish. **\$10.95**

HUNTINGTON Petite Sirah California 2005

This Petite Sirah is an amazing wine with its subtle layers of fruit and a rich jammy intensity that rather than going over the top, shows refinement and finesse in every sip. **\$11.00**

MCMANIS - Petite Sirah California 2007

Heavy on the cola, spice and cedar notes, with ripe dark fruit flavors on a medium body. The chunky tannins are just what you'd expect from a Petite. **\$11.00**

TRENTADUE - Petite Sirah California 2007

The 2007 vintage is shaping up to become one of the great vintages in this decade. This is a fruity wine showing intensely ripe and almost syrupy aromas and flavors of blueberry, blackberry and plums, which are typical for Petite Sirah. The color is intense dark purple, suggesting deep extraction and full body with a long, juicy and viscous finish. Further aeration reveals deeper, complex aromas of leather, cocoa powder, molasses and maple. This is a well endowed wine that will get better with age, Cheers! **\$15.00**
