

## ZINFANDEL WINE LIST

### **7 DEADLY ZINS – 2007 - Lodi**

Notes of sweet plums and pepper dominate the nose, while flavors of blueberry, raspberry, cinnamon, and black pepper pack the palate from start to finish. The silky-smooth tannins hold the wine together and deliver a soft, fruit driven experience. **\$15.95**

### **BOGEL - 2007**

This supple and full-bodied vintage begins with brambleberries and raspberry jam. Summertime ripeness and richness integrate with hints of black pepper and a touch of dark chocolate. The finish of toasty oak, tobacco and spicy cloves creates a wine of both structure and sumptuousness. **\$10.95**

### **BRAZIN – Zinfandel 2007**

The Grade: OUTSTANDING. Like it states on the label, a (b)old vine Zinfandel. It's full-bodied, with big, pronounced tannins, and has a robust flavor profile of dark plums, chocolate and black currants. This is a pretty impressive effort from the good folks at Delicato Family Vineyards, and a lot of wine for the price. **\$16.80**

### **CLINE - 2007 Ancient Vines Zinfandel**

The 2007 Ancient Vines Zinfandel shows wonderful dusty raspberry, blackberry, white pepper and spice, with coffee and chocolate characters. Ripe fruit and soft tannins make this a mouth-coating rich vintage. Aging in new and used wood has lent this wine a subtle vanilla quality that nicely complements the explosive fruit notes. **\$13.35**

### **GNARLY HEAD – 2006 - Lodi**

Robust berry flavors and exotic spice notes from the small grape clusters are balanced with French, American and Hungarian oak, which creates heady layers of vanilla and chocolate and a lingering finish. **\$9.95**

### **GNARLIER HEAD – 2005 Dry Creek Valley**

This single vineyard Gnarlier Head Zinfandel starts with aromas of spicy cloves, red berries and cigar box. Gnarlier Head Zin delivers big, round, rich flavors of juicy dark berries, ripe plums, wild raspberries and hints of vanilla, mocha and pepper. **\$18.20**

### **L de LYETH - California 2006**

**Nose:** Savory purity of fruit with both aromas and flavors of plum and cherry.

**Palate:** Fruit bomb, with seductive highlights of white cracked pepper and hints of green bell pepper. Fine soft ripe tannins add a velvety richness, with a broad mouth feel. **\$9.95**

### **PLUNGER HEAD - 2007 Lodi Zinfandel**

This medium-plum colored Zinfandel is very forward with rich and sappy French oak notes, with ripe raspberry and bramble notes up front. The core of the wine is very robust with dark fruit including black cherry and cassis followed by generous and integrated spice flavors of star anise, cardamom, licorice with ample coffee flavors on the backside which finishes with the classic old vine, resinous finish. **\$14.55**

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### **RIDGE - 2006 YORK CREEK ZINFANDEL**

Deep ruby with a bright rim. Raspberry, cherry and cinnamon on the nose. Bright with nervy red berry flavors and notes of vanilla and bitter chocolate. A medium-bodied zinfandel with fully absorbed tannins and impressive finishing lift. **Sexy wine! \$28.50**

### **RIDGE - 2007 PONZO VINEYARD ZINFANDEL**

Blackberry jam, tart plumb, crushed peppercorn, dusty mineral earth. Full bodied, **exotic** red/black raspberry fruit. ~~\$30.50~~ **SALE \$24.00**

### **SPENKER WINERY 2001 Estate Zin**

This robust wine is packed with fat, ripe fruit--cherries, cassis, blackberries--yet has enough acidity to give it lift. Smoky, cola flavors are almost overpowering, but not quite. A terrific wine from an underrated region. **\$10.00**

### **THUMB PRINT - 2006**

Dark cherry, blackberry, nutmeg and toast aromas and flavors develop intense complexity. Brilliant acidity melds these complex flavors with tantalizing tannins through the full rich finish. **\$31.35**
